GENERAL FUND: Both Income and Expenses have an annual budget of \$4,612.200. As of February 28, 2023 the Income was \$535,252.29 or 11.6 % of the budgeted Income. Expenses were \$820,505.79 or 17.8 % of the budgeted Expenses. Balance in the General fund accounts as of February 28, 2023 was \$528,986.11

<u>SEWER FUND</u>: Both Income and Expenses have an annual budget of \$2,146,000.00 As of February 28, 2023, the Income was \$237,445.38 or 11.1 % of the budgeted Income. Expenses were \$419,996.05 or 19.6% of the budgeted Expenses. Balance in the Sewer Fund accounts as of February 28, 2023 was \$728,114.17.

<u>COVID-19 ARPA Recovery Fund:</u> As of February 28, 2023 balance in the COVID-19 ARPA Recovery Fund is \$103.956.28

CSX Account: As of February 28, 2023 balance in the CSX Account was \$744,364.80.
