SEWER FUND: Income and Expenses have an annual budget of \$2,146,000.00 As of October 31, Income was \$1,817,821.13 or 84.7% of the budgeted Income. Expenses were \$1,594,783.24 or 74.3% of the budgeted Expenses. Balance in the Sewer Fund as of October 31, 2023 \$1,135,813.33
